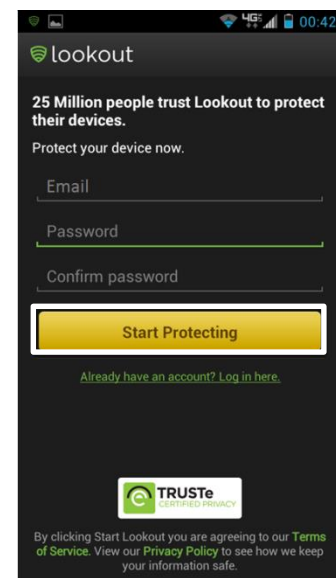
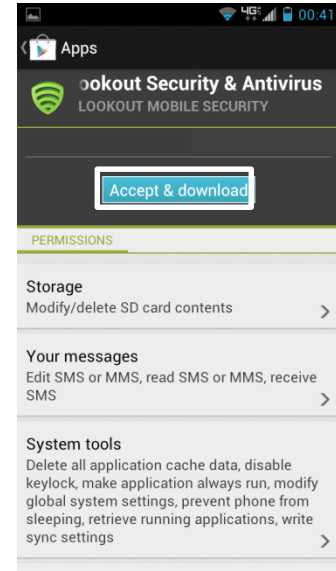

How to Install Lookout Security & Antivirus



1. Go to Google Play store
2. Search for “Lookout Security & Antivirus”
3. Click “Install” button
4. Read permissions and make sure you agree with all of them & trust the application enough to install “Lookout Security & Antivirus”
5. Click “Accept & Download”
6. Wait for the download to finish
7. Read the “Welcome to Lookout” tutorial
8. When you are done with the tutorial, you will need to create a Lookout account by providing an email and password.
 - Do NOT use the same password as you do for your email account.

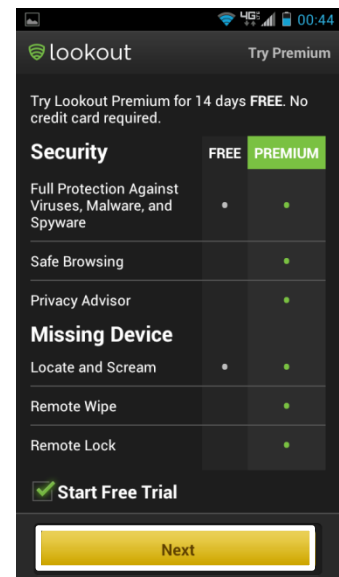


9. Choose to either “Upgrade Now” to the premium version (paid) of Lookout or “No Thanks” to stay with the free version.



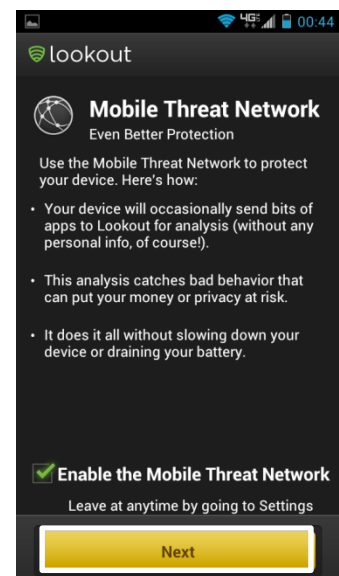
10. Accept or deny the Free 14 Day Trial. Click “Next”

- To refuse the trial, uncheck the “Start Free Trial”



11. Accept or deny Mobile Threat Network. Click “Next”

- Sends data about apps (no personal info) to Lookout for analysis to help stop malicious applications.

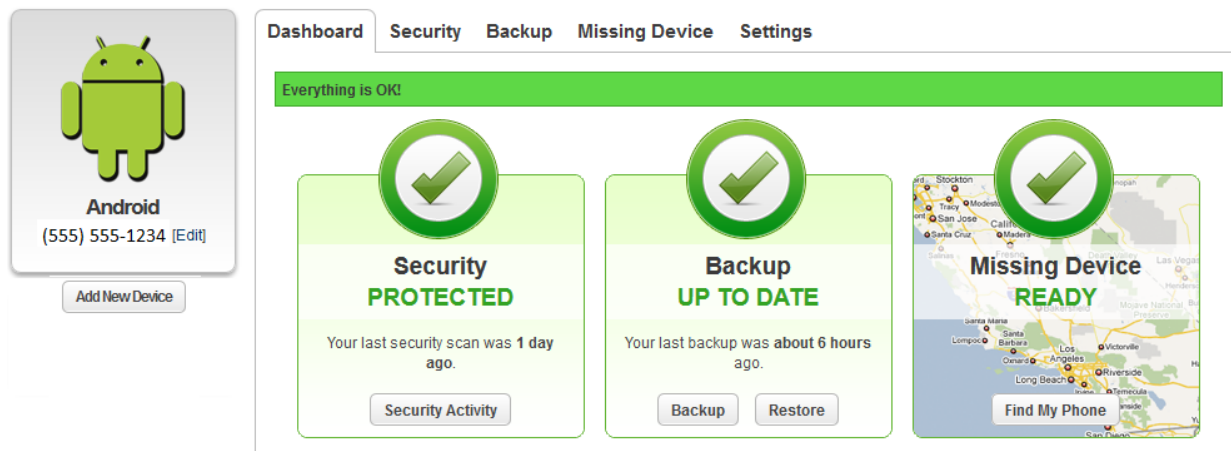

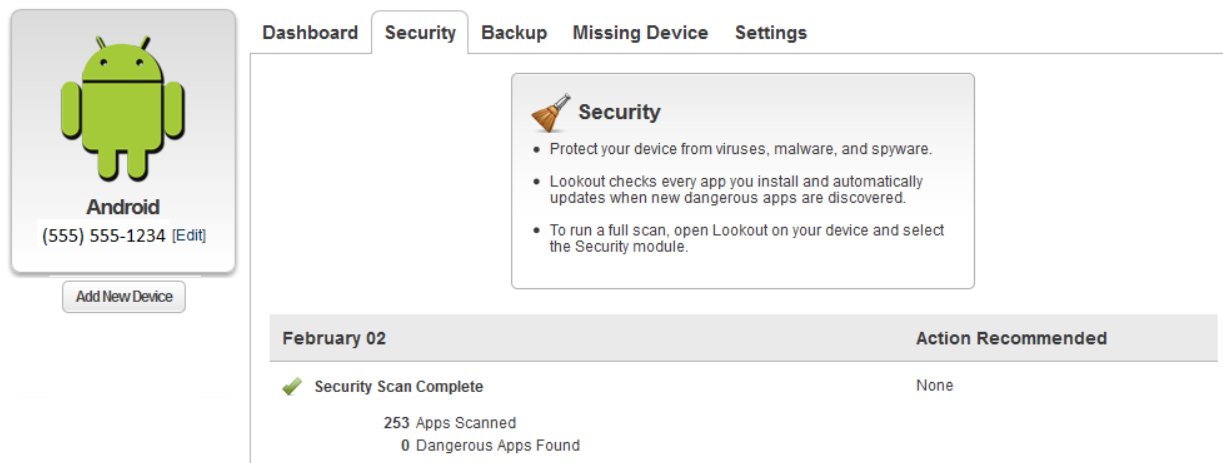

Accessing: Lookout Security & Antivirus

1. Open up a web browser and navigate to www.lookout.com
2. Press the “Login” button and login using the email and password associated with your account.
3. From the homepage you can manage all of the devices associated with your account.



4. From the security tab you can view a report of the latest scans and any recommended actions

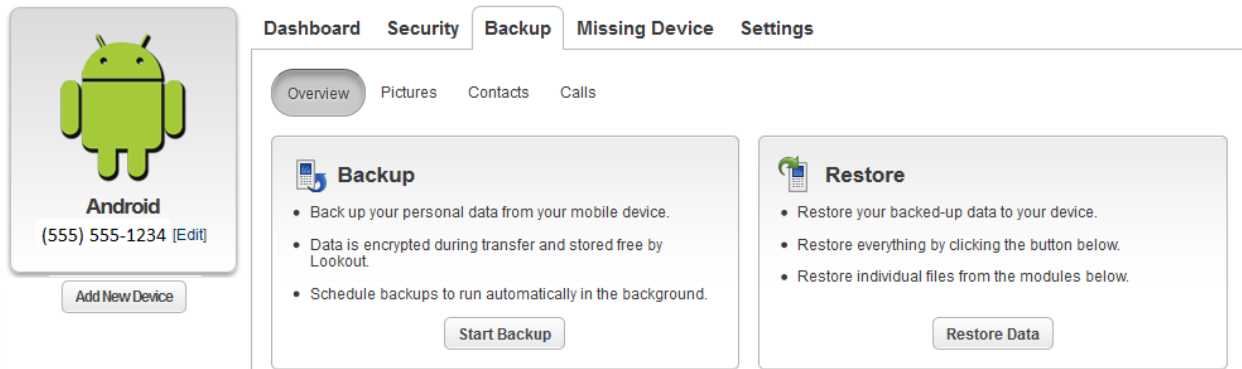

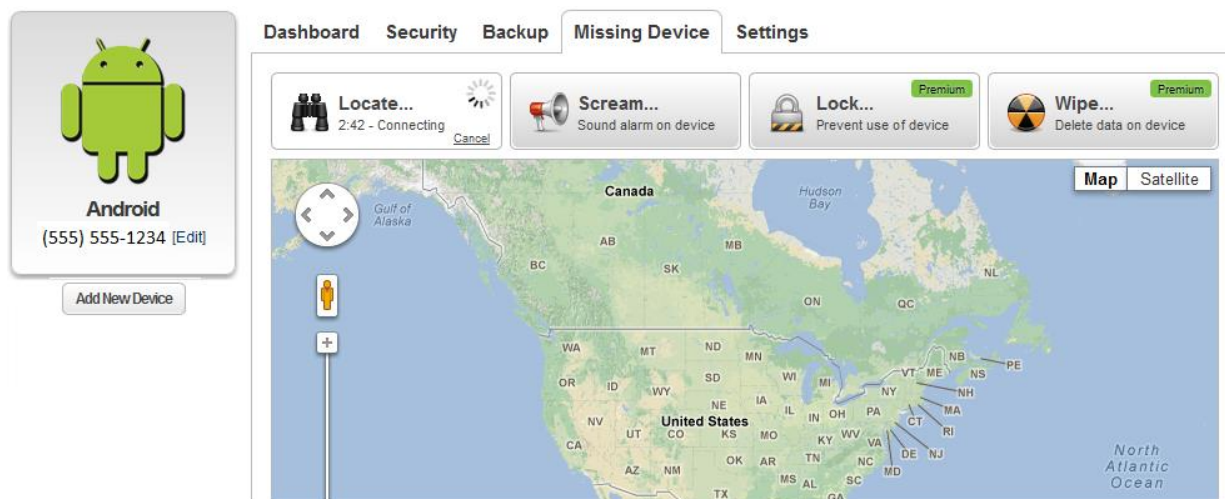
5. The backup tab you can view everything Lookout backs up.

- Note: Some backup features are available only to premium members.



6. The missing device tab displays the various actions available should you lose your device or have it stolen

- Note: Some of these features are available only to premium members



7. From the settings tab you can change what items Lookout backups, security settings and how Lookout responds to a missing device.
